Helpful questions you can ask at your school to help you receive all the services you need:

*What transportation is available for me to stay in the same school?

*If I have to change schools, can someone help me transfer records quickly?

*Are any tutoring services available for me?

*If I need special education services, how long is the wait for testing?

*Are there special classes to benefit a talent I have?

*Are there sports, music, or other activities I can be a part of?

*How can I receive free meals at school?

*Are school supplies available?

*Will I be able to go on class field trips if I am unable to pay?

*How can I get a required school uniform if I cannot afford one?

H.A.R.P.—Homeless Awareness and Response Program

The Federal McKinney-Vento Act and Texas State Law, guarantee that you can enroll in school if you live:

*in a shelter;

*in a motel or hotel;

*in a house or an apartment with more than one family because of economic hardship or loss;

*in an abandoned building or a car, at a campground, or on the street;

*in temporary foster care or with an adult who is not your parent or legal guardian;

*in substandard housing; or

*with friends or family because you are a runaway or unaccompanied youth.

If you live in one of these situations, you do not need to provide:

*proof of residency;

*immunization records;

*birth certificate;

*school records; or legal guardianship papers

to enroll in school.

You may also:

*Continue to attend the school in which you were last enrolled, even if you have moved away from that school's attendance zone or district:;

*receive transportation from your current residence back to your school of origin;

*qualify automatically for Child Nutrition Programs;

*participate fully in all school activities and programs for which you are eligible; and

*contact the district liaison to resolve any disputes that arise during the enrollment process.



When you move, you should do the following:

*Ask the campus contact for help in enrolling in a new school or arranging to continue in the school you have been attending.

*Contact the school and provide any information you think will assist the teachers in helping you adjust to new circumstances.

*Ask the local liaison, shelter staff, or a social worker from one of the agencies that is assisting you for help with clothing and supplies, if needed.
