Applications will be reviewed by the scholarship committee and those students ranking in the top 20% will be invited to an in person, essay interview. Masks will be required upon entry and social distancing will be in place.

Winners will be notified by email no later than January 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Scholarship recipients must attend the virtual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Commemoration Program where they will be recognized on Monday, January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2021. **Scholarship money will be disbursed directly to the university, college, vocation or trade school no later than September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021.** Students will be required to provide verification of enrollment prior to disbursement of funds. Failure to provide verification of enrollment by **September 24<sup>th</sup>**, 2021 will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
