(Students participating in student teaching, internships, and cooperative education programs, and study abroad programs who are enrolled in less than 12 hours during a fall or spring semester may be eligible to be certified as a full-time student with the approval of the Dean of the College or his or her designee. <u>A letter</u> of certification must be included with this application.)
- 2. The applicant shall be in good standing and shall have a minimum weighted GPA of 3.5. An unofficial <u>original</u> transcript (all pages), which shows proof of classes taken and of the student's GPA.
- 3. The applicant will reside in Killeen, Harker Heights, Fort Hood, Nolanville, or Belton, Texas.
