New Graduation Requirement!!

Beginning with students enrolled in 12th grade during the 2021-2022 school year, each student must do one of the following in order to graduate:

Complete and submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), or •
 Complete and submit a

Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA), **or**

 Submit a signed opt-out form to your school counselor

eligible to receive financial aid (grants, loans, work study programs, etc.). Many colleges will offer you scholarships based upon your FAFSA submission also. **The**

FAFSA opened on October 1st, 2021. Your best chance to receive aid is to

apply EARLY.

TASFA: If you are a foreign student or noncitizen, you may be eligible to be classified as a Texas resident for tuition purposes. If so, you may also be eligible to receive state financial aid. The TASFA deadline is **January 15th**, **2022.**

Opt-Out Form: Students who do not completed a FAFSA or TASFA, may fulfill the graduation requirement by submitting a completed and signed Opt-Out form to your school counselor.



FINANCIAL AID

The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is the online form used when applying for financial aid. This is the first step in the financial aid process. Complete the FAFSA online at www.fafsa.ed.gov.

Tuesday, November 9, Ellison High School will be hosting a FAFSA/Financial Aid Night for seniors and their parents. This event will start at 6:00 pm in the cafeteria; a representative from Texas A & M University – Central Texas will present an overview of the FAFSA, financial aid, and military educational benefits. Parents and students will move to school computer labs to work on their FAFSA applications; attached is a checklist of documents to bring for working on the FAFSA. The evening concludes at 7:30.

THE ASVAB test will be given here in the auditorium on Wednesday, November 17, 2021. Sign up in the counselors' office.

Representatives from CTC and Texas A&M-Central Texas will be in the library during 3rd period and in the commons during Power Hour on Wednesday, November 10, 2021. Sign up in the Counselors' Office to attend the 3rd period session. No sign up is needed for Power Hour.

COLLEGE APPLICATIONS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship information is available in the Counselors' Office on the wall labeled "Scholarships". Due to COVID-19, print outs of individual scholarship applications will not be available in the counselor's office. The Registrar's Office will be happy to mail your completed applications if they are turned in at least **TEN** days before they are due to their destination.
