**Available Scholarships:** Jerry Johnson (\$2500), Dan Bray (\$1500), and Stan Passman – Overcoming Challenges (\$1000).

**Scholarship Criteria**: Awards for scholarships will be based on a combination of grades, references, activities and overall potential for success in a college/or higher level educational environment.

Jerry Johnson: Primary emphasis is not grades, but rather second tier students who have a chance to succeed when he/she might not qualify for some of the other scholarships that are based on academics or athletics.

Dan Bray: Primary emphasis is community service and academic achievement, which indicates the student will be successful in a college/higher level educational environment and continue to give back to their community. Students who do not include community service activities will not be included in this award.

Stan Passman - Overcoming Challenges: The recipient should be a Pathways student or have overcome significant obstacles to complete their education. Applicants for this scholarship should be well-rounded students with a heart for service. - List of other scholarships received
- List of community service or volunteer activities participated in while in high school
- College, university, or trade show letter of acceptance
- Three letters of recommendation addressing your leadership and/or community service contributions
- In 500 words or less, please answer this question in the form of a personal essay: Jerry Johnson and Dan Bray Applicants "Who or what helped you identify and develop your talents and how will you use these talents to help other people?" Stan Passman Applicants "What challenges have you overcome to continue your education and how have those challenges shaped you as a person?" Note: Applicants are expected to produce an original essay using a computer and word processing program. Format is 1" margins, single-spaced, font size 12, and style Times New Roman
