#### **ENROLLMENT**

Students may earn up to 2 one-half credit per session. First semester courses (A) will be offered during the first session, and second semester courses (B) will be offered during the second session. Half-credit course (such as economics and government) will be offered both sessions. Classes with less than 15 students enrolled are subject to cancellation.

#### APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

Students may not enroll for credit advancement if credit recovery is needed.

- 75 average in content area courses requesting advancement
- No recommendations for removal to alternative discipline placement
- No more than 2 discipline referrals during the school year
- Approval of the Campus Principal or designee
- Passed and current on all EOC/STAAR test taken to date

#### **EDGENUITY STATEMENT**

If you complete the A portion before June 24<sup>th</sup>, you will still begin the B portion June 28<sup>th</sup>.

Late applications WILL NOT be accepted. Students will be notified of acceptance or declination by the end of May.

\*Remember for summer school advancement if accepted you must register for both Session I and Session II of course unless you have already received partial credit before summer session or if you are wishing to attend Government or Economics\*
