



**Women's Army Corp Veterans Association

PURPOSE:

To assist and encourage graduating female students to pursue their education at an institution of higher learning. It is hoped that the topic chosen will inspire the thinking of our female youth, who will assume the responsibility of leadership for the future of women.

ELIGIBILITY:

Female applicant's only

Graduating Seniors in any High School or Home School within the state of Texas may apply. Students in ROTC or looking for a future in the military service are encouraged to participate.

Graduated/GED* applicants, between 17 through 21 years of age, entering their first year of college or a higher learning institution, within the state of Texas may apply.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD:

The author of the best essay submitted will be the scholarship winner. In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined based on academic achievements. The award will be submitted to the college of the winner's choice.

Award amount: Varies between \$500 and \$1,000

RULES:

Essays are to be no fewer than 500 words nor more than 750 words in length and must be computer generated, double spaced, on one side only of 8 ½ x 11" paper. Quotations from other writers are acceptable but must be acknowledged in bibliography. Essays will be screened for plagiarism.

A copy of the essay must be submitted with the application.

The application must be filled out completely, including academic information.

CRITERIA:

The criteria used by the judges in selecting the winners will be based on a system that accurately scores the essays such as historical accuracy, content, writing quality (spelling and grammar), research references and whether the applicant followed instructions.

DEADLINE:

Entries must be postmarked on or before May 1st the year of submission. The original essay, application, transcripts, and any additional sheets you needed, should be sent to Women's Army Corp Veterans Association, Genevieve Chapter #94, P.O. Box 11544, Killeen, Texas 76547-1544
