



Killeen ISD Continued Learning Plan

Elementary Information Sheet

Parents,

Your child's teachers are committed to providing teaching and learning opportunities in response to the Coronavirus (COVID-19). Through a continued learning plan and the support of our teachers, students will continue learning at home as we work to reopen schools.

Continued Learning Opportunities:

1. Continued learning in reading and math for pre-kindergarten through 5th grade students will be accessed through the **KISD Continued Learning Center** website (which will be active on Wednesday, March 25 at 8:00 a.m.) The web address is https://killeenisd.org/continued_learning_center
2. In addition to the learning activities, beginning on **Wednesday, March 25, 2020**, students will have access to three online learning programs:
 - **ST Math** with new content made available
 - **Imagine Math**
 - **Imagine Language and Literacy**
3. Teachers will connect with students in fun and creative ways using whatever communication format the students and families are accustomed to using.
4. In addition to the online learning, the learning packet activities, ST Math, and the Imagine Learning programs, students may work on campus provided resources.

Access:

1. For the week of March 25th, families who indicated a need for hard-copy packets may pick up the packets at their home campus on Wednesday, March 25, 8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.
 - Learning packets may be returned to the campus on Monday, March 30, 8:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m.
2. For the week of March 30th, learning opportunities will be completed online.
 - Families who indicated that they had access to technology, but not a printer, will be able to accomplish continued learning totally online.
 - Families without technology will continue to pick up packets at the home campus on March 30, 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Students and Teachers:

1. Students are expected to login and begin their online learning **OR** begin completing learning packets beginning Wednesday, March 25, 2020.
2. Teacher assistance and support will be available during regularly scheduled school hours. Teachers will share with families and students how they will provide assistance, support, and communication.

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Grades:

We do not want any student's grades to be negatively impacted due to the school closure. Instead, we want this to be an opportunity for students to improve their grades through participation and engagement.

Dyslexia:

If a student is actively enrolled in the dyslexia program, he or she will be provided with daily learning as required for fidelity implementation of the Wilson Reading Program. Teachers will reach out to their students and provide daily customized video tutorials and lessons.

PPCD, SKILLS, CASD, and Resource Courses:

Special Education self-contained and resource teachers are expected to connect with their students and provide engaging, customized, learning activities for their students.
