If selected, there are certain personal and financial responsibilities and obligations, which you and your child must assume in order to qualify and remain a member in good standing. This packet contains all of the information that you will need to know before making the decision on whether or not to allow your child to try out. We hope that you, as a parent of a prospective dancer, are aware of the time and energy it takes to be an effective student leader here at Nolan.

Because we believe our school and students are "Better than the Best!" we always expect the dancers to set good examples of student conduct. We have set forth guidelines that will make our dancers role models at our school. We want our dancers to be exemplary citizens exhibiting high moral and academic standards.

It is our intention that in after reading through this packet with your child, you will discuss the expectations and obligations of being an NMS dancer with. Our organization helps students form friendships, improve communication skills, and develop leadership skills that will prove to be beneficial later in life.

We wish all candidates the best of luck. Please read this packet carefully and be sure you fully understand each rule and procedure **BEFORE** signing. The last pages of this packet must be signed and returned by **April 8, 2022**. **No late applications will be accepted!!!**

Dancer Expectations

Expectations for dancers and other student leaders at Nolan Middle School are extremely high. Please make sure you have read this packet **VERY** carefully, as it describes the schedule requirements and rules for elected dancers. If you cannot abide by the schedule requirements and/or rules, please reconsider trying out.

Grades: Dancer candidates must maintain passing grades or risk extended probation/termination. Students **MUST** have passed the 3rd nine weeks to tryout. If they did not pass, then they **MUST** have passed the current progress report. Please turn in a copy of the report card and the current progress report if needed, with the application.

Time: If elected, plan to spend an average of four hours per week practicing dances, technique, and physical fitness for dance performances.

Transportation: Each parent/guardian must arrange for his/her own child's ride to and from games, practices, performances, and other dance functions. You will be given a calendar for all dance functions; therefore, parents are responsible for their child's timely arrival to events.

Dancers will be issued demerits (which leads up to benching of performances) if parent/guardian is more than 15 minutes late picking them up. After two warnings, decision will be made by sponsor and principal for possible removal from the squad.

Attendance: Do not plan to try out for the dance team unless you plan to attend all games, practices, and dance functions. (Doctor's appointments without a doctor's note are not excused). Missing

practices will result in being benched during the next game. Unexcused absences may result in the removal from the squad.

Rules and Behavior: Keep in mind that being a dance member is a privilege to which one is elected. The strictest consideration for, and adherence to all rules is mandatory. If a referral is issued for a dancer, it may result in removal from the squad. A referral for fighting, bullying or any other referral labeled serious WILL result in removal from the team. If a dancer goes to the alternative school, they will not be allowed on the team when they return.

Being a dance member is an honor and special privilege. The dance team exist to promote good sportsmanship, good citizenship, wholesome, and enthusiastic school spirit and are first and foremost representatives of their school. Dancers should exemplify both individual and group behavior suitable to their position and in accordance with the rules as stated in the KISD Student Code of Conduct. Members of these groups have a fundamental responsibility to play a leadership role in building teamwork and helping the school achieve its goals and objectives. Because of these responsibilities, members of the dance team will be expected to maintain a higher standard of behavior both on and off campus and academic achievement than that of their peers.

<u>Teacher Recommendation</u>: Keep in mind that being a dancer is a privilege to which one is elected. The strictest consideration for, and

adherence to all rules **is mandatory**. How one represents his/herself in class is very important in maintaining the positive image of the entire Nolan Campus. Candidates will need to give their teachers the recommendation form to fill out and their teacher will oversee submitting it to Mrs. Bark's box. Each positive recommendation (example- this student is wonderful in class, and respectful all the time) will earn 100 points. Negative recommendations (example- this student shows disrespect to his/her peers and teachers and refuses to follow directions given) will earn 0 points. Neutral recommendations (ex. they are really great, but have a problem talking in class) will earn 50 points.

All candidates and parents are required to attend the parent information meeting.

You will perform basic dance skills, learn a dance routine, and perform the routine during tryouts for judges. These will be taught during the clinics, so it is **very important that you attend all clinics days leading up to tryouts. If a day is missed, then you will not be allowed to return to tryouts the following day. **

If you are late to tryouts, you will not have another opportunity to try out for the NMS dance team. Once the tryouts have started, you will not be allowed in the school.

If your child makes the team, you will need to refer to the dates on the next page.

MIDDLE SCHOOL DANCE TRYOUT SEQUENCE OF EVENTS

CLINICS: During the clinic days students will learn a dance routine to perform in a group to the judges on tryout day. Students will also be learning required dance skills that are necessary to make the team.

TRYOUT DAY: On tryout day students will be split into their groups. Students will walk into the gym in their groups and be asked to perform their dance, then show their ability to do the following skills: splits, double turns, and leaps.

Tryout Requirements and Selection of Dancers

Candidates are required to wear the following on tryout day:

- Black athletic shorts
- Solid black T-Shirt
- Athletic shoes
- Hair in a ponytail

Parents will not be allowed in the building during any phase of the tryouts. Candidates will be released after they are finished with their audition.

Every attempt is made to hire judges that have not worked with students in Nolan. However, with the hundreds of camps in the state of Texas, attended by thousands of dancers and taught by hundreds of instructors, it may be possible at some time that a member of the judging panel may have had some contact with a candidate who is

trying out. Professional judges with outstanding credential and references will be hired for all tryouts. They will be instructed to judge the candidates based only on the mastery of the skills that they see demonstrated during the tryouts. Tryout results will not be challenged because of prior knowledge of judges and candidates. Paired with the tryout points, candidates will turn in 5 teacher recommendations each worth 20 points.
