Electronic Devices

To keep the academic environment free from distractions per KISD policy, personal telecommunication/electronic devices/headphones are prohibited on school property during the school day from 7:30 am – 3:30 pm.

Exception is when using district or campus technology within an instructional setting.

If an electronic device is confiscated:

A Type II District Conduct Violation will be documented, **AND** the device shall be turned into the Assistant Principal's office according to the student's last name for safe keeping.

- On the 1st Offense:
 - The student will be allowed to pick up the device at the end of the school day.
- On the 2nd Offense:
 - A parent/guardian can pick up the device from the student's assigned Assistant Principal's office <u>or</u> the student will be allowed to pick up the device after 5 school days.
- On the 3rd Offense:
 - A parent/guardian can pick up the device from the student's assigned Assistant Principal's office <u>or</u> the student will be allowed to pick up the device after 10 school days.

• Subsequent Offenses:

• A parent/guardian pick up **ONLY**

*If parent picks up phone at any time other than the end of the school day, the device must be taken home for the day.

If student refuses to submit the telecommunication/electronic device, teachers **SHALL provide an opportunity to comply AND document parent contact.

***Students who continue to refuse to submit the telecommunication/electronic device after teacher intervention **MAY** receive a referral for Telecommunications/Electronic Devices.
