The STEM Academy is a program for sixth through eighth graders who are interested in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. This is a college-preparatory program for grades 6 – 8 located at Roy J. Smith Middle School, 6000 Brushy Creek Drive, Killeen, Texas and Nolan Middle School, 1600 Warriors Path, Harker Heights, Texas. There will also be 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade cohorts at Eastern Hills Middle School, Manor Middle School, and Rancier Middle School. The goal of the STEM Academy is to support a diverse learning community based on common interests. The STEM Academy supports students in developing a vision of future academic and career possibilities and enables students to translate those visions into the realities of college graduation, informed citizenship, and international leadership.

All students in the Killeen ISD attendance zone who are in grades 6 – 8 during the 2024-2025 school year are eligible to apply. Students who submit a completed application will be included in the lottery selection process. The lottery will determine which students will be offered enrollment in the STEM Academy. Students not selected will be placed on a waiting list.
