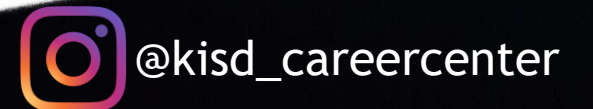


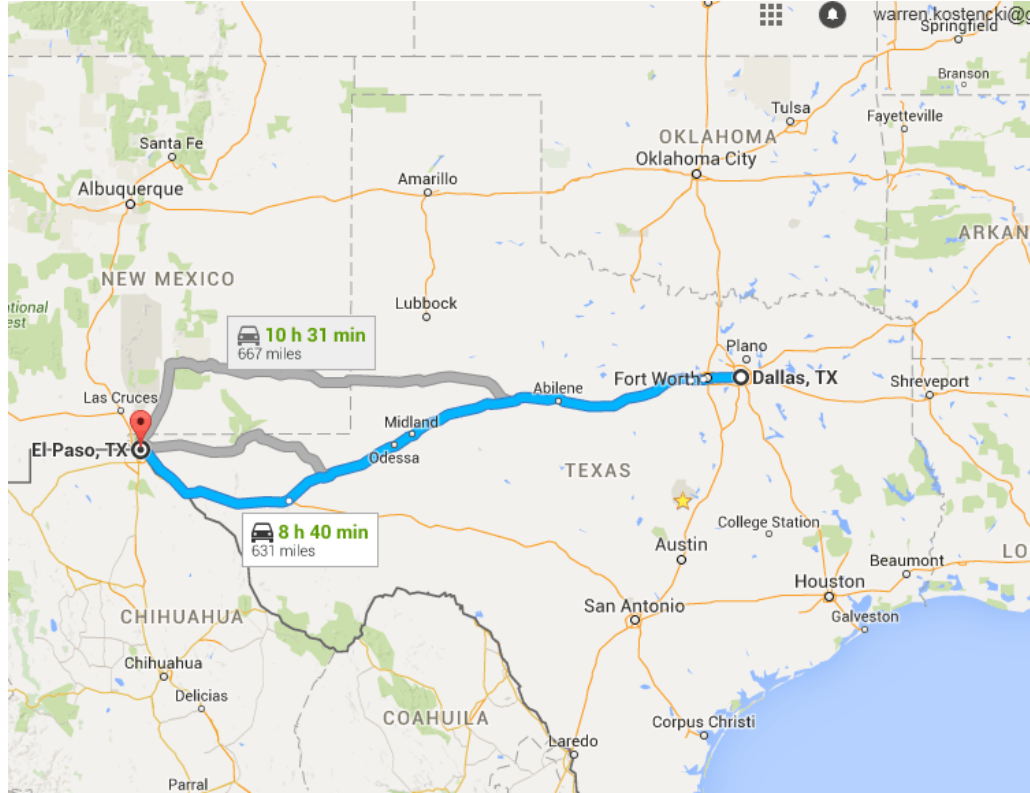

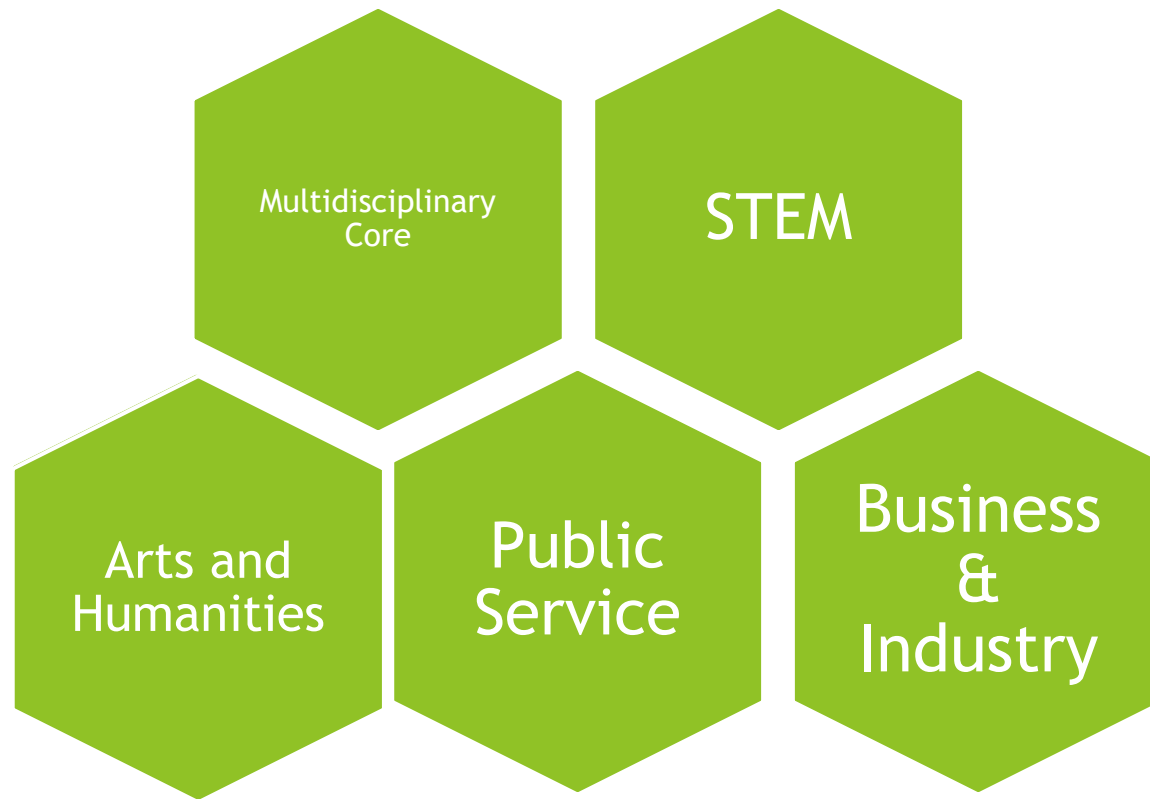


Graduation Requirements

- Students must have 26 credits to graduate. (Credits must be earned in the appropriate courses to graduate)
 - Students must have the following to graduate. (Some Endorsements may require students to have additional credits in these areas.)
 - 4.0 Credits of English
 - 4.0 Credits of Math
 - 4.0 Credits of Science
 - 3.0 Credits of Social Studies
 - 1.0 Credit of Fine Arts
 - 1.0 Credit of PE
 - 2.0 Credits of LOTE/Foreign Language (Both years must be the same language)
 - 7.0 Credits of Electives/Endorsements
 - You must take and pass the End of Course STAAR exams to graduate. These courses are English I, English II, Biology, Algebra I and US History.
- *waivers for 20192020 EOC's were given if you took the EOC class and passed the course.

Please carefully review your Career Plan as your credits are your responsibility

Students must identify an endorsement in writing upon entering 9th grade

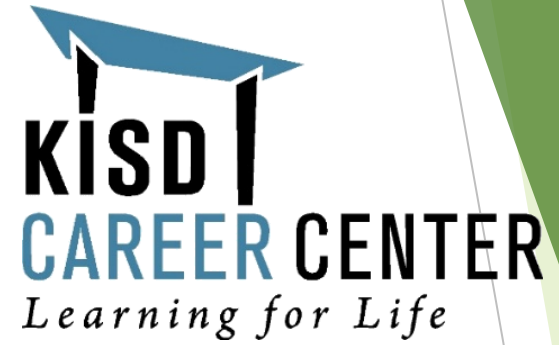
