### EARLY LITERACY CLUBS

## Summer Programs

### LOVE OF LEARNING LITERACY CLUB

Summer enrichment is an 8-day program designed for children 3-4-year-olds not enrolled in school. It is an extension of the Early Literacy Clubs offered during the school year.

### BACKPACK PROGRAM

Summer Take-Home Backpack Program allows families to check out grade level specific materials to review and maintain academic skills that were learned during the school year. (Grades PK-9th)
