- Inspire parents and community to collaborate with the school district in enriching education.

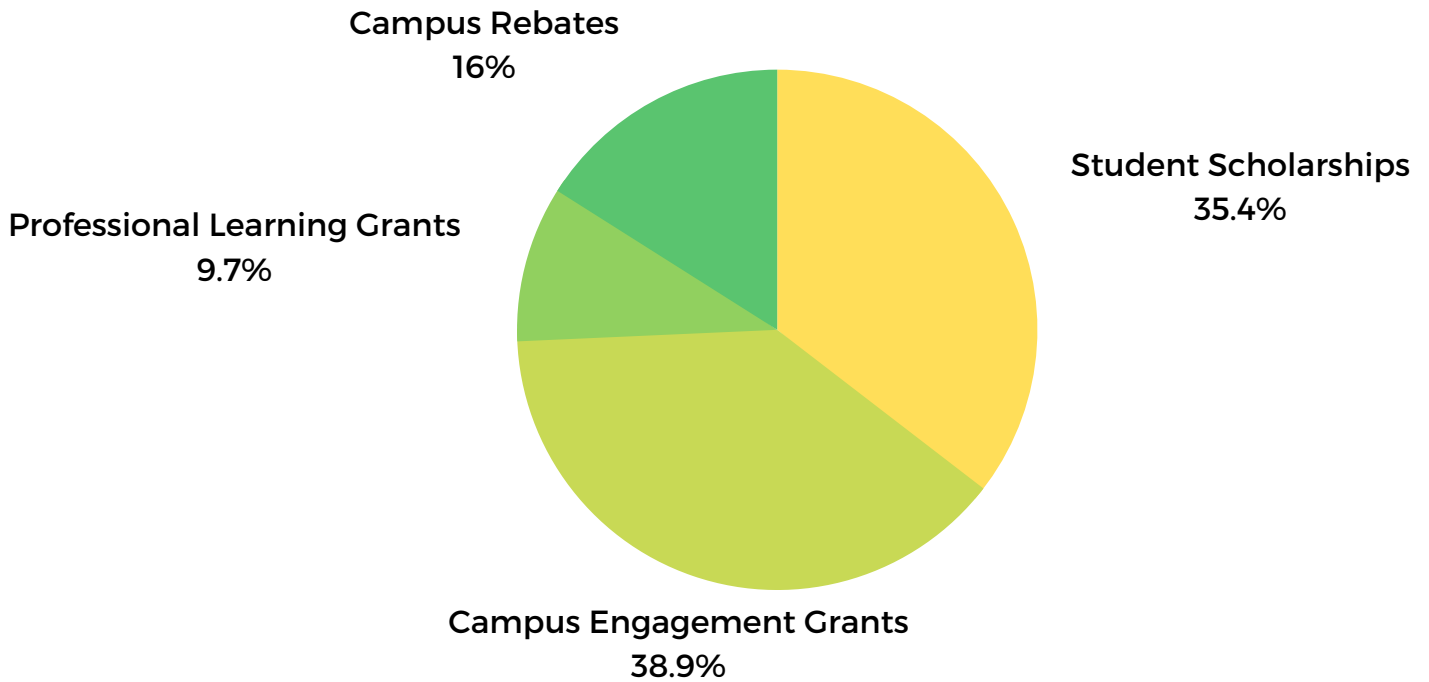
FUNDING PRIORITIES

2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR

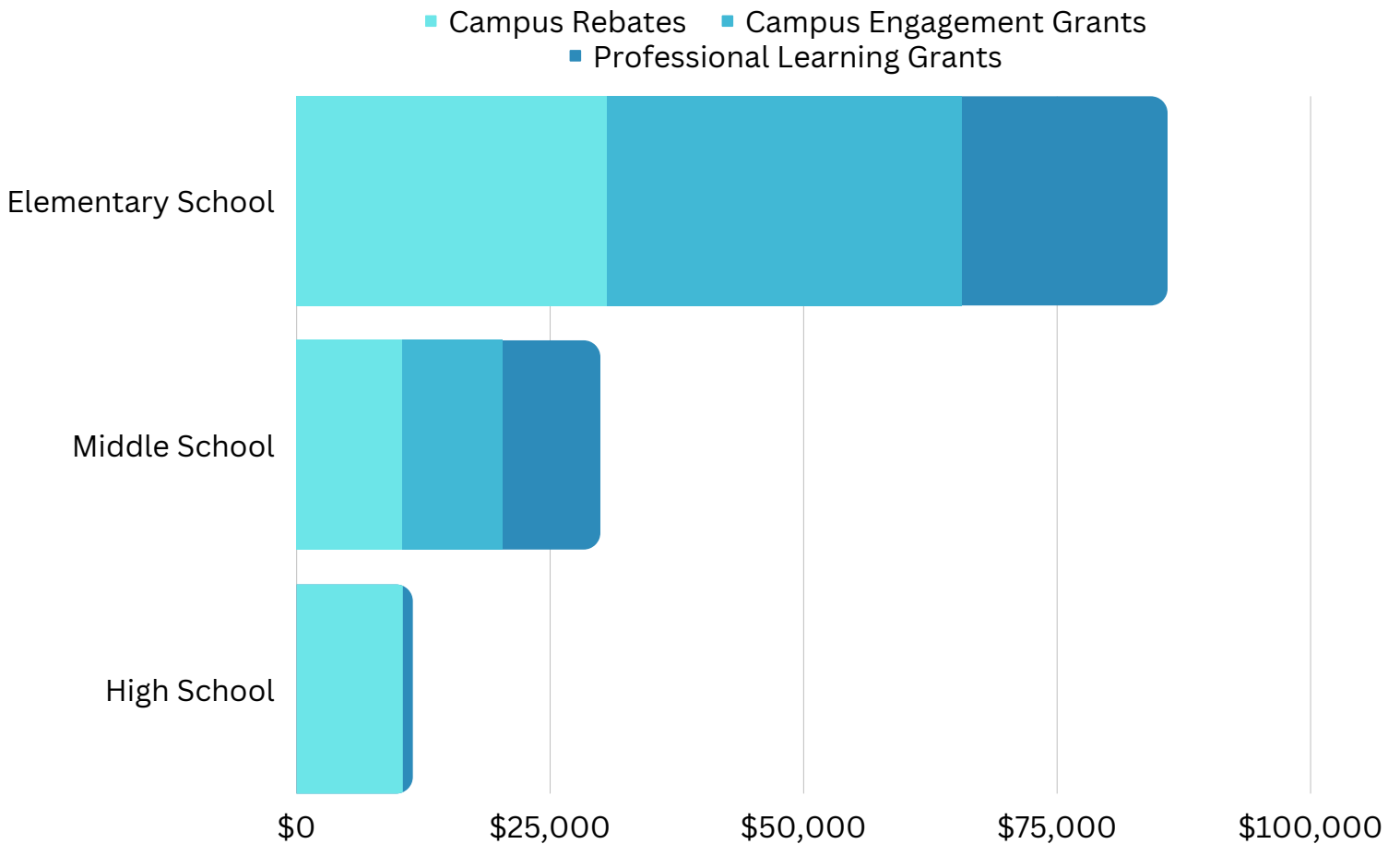


The Killeen ISD Education Foundation disburses funding to programs throughout the school year.
