SCHEDULE

Session I: June 3 – June 17, 2025

Session II: June 18-June 26 and July 7-July 10, 2025

Virtual TEACHER WORKDAY: 7:30AM -1:00PM (teachers will ONLY be available during these hours while you work on your course)

Teachers will not be available after 1:00PM.

ENROLLMENT

Students may earn one-half credit per session. First semester courses (A) will be offered during the first session, and second semester courses (B) will be offered during the second session. Half-credit courses (such as economics and government) will be offered during both sessions. Classes with less than 15 students enrolled are subject to cancellation.

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

Students may not enroll for credit advancement if credit recovery is needed.

Students must have:

- A 75% or higher average in the last content area course, in which the advancement course is requested
- Approval of the Campus Principal or designee

****If a student needs remediation they will be removed from Advancement and enrolled in Recovery.****

EDGENUITY STATEMENT

Applicants are required to sign up for both the A and B semester of the course in which they wish to gain credit. Edgenuity courses are self-paced, and students are responsible for completing the A semester during session I and the B semester in session II. If the A portion is completed before June 17th, the B portion will still begin on June 18th.

Late applications WILL NOT be accepted. Students will be notified of acceptance or declination by June 2nd.

KISD will NOT issue devices for Summer Learning Advancement.

It is recommended to have a device using Chrome.

Cell phones are not recommended for Edgenuity work.
