## **TEXAS STATE COLLEGE TUITION ASSISTANCE**

\$9,000 a year tuition at any of the Texas Public Colleges and Universities. Serve locally, part-time while attending college fulltime, you could graduate debt free!

## **THE HAZELWOOD ACT**

The Hazlewood Act is a State of Texas benefit that provides qualified Veterans, spouses, and dependent children with an education benefit of **up to 150 hours of tuition exemption**, including most fee charges, at public institutions of higher education in Texas.

---

## **GI BILL \$407 PER MONTH**

Tax Free Stipend While Attending College Full-time, this stipend will be deposited directly into your account, amount is pro-rated if attending part-time.

---

## **GI BILL KICKER \$200 PER MONTH**

Additional Stipend bonus, if qualified you'd earn \$597 a month tax free straight into your pocket while attending college fulltime!!

## **FEDERAL TUITION ASSISTANCE**

\$4,000 Per Year, can be used towards academic certificates, bachelors, and masters degree.
