



Credit Recovery at Student's Home (CRASH)

Welcome to the HHS Credit Recovery Program. Credit Recovery at Student's Home (CRASH) provides students the opportunity to retake courses they completed but did not earn the required credit for graduation. Students who only need to recover 0.5 credits per semester may qualify for CRASH. CRASH students will work in Edgenuity to complete their courses outside of the school day.

1. **Students who are scheduled in CRASH must have their own device to work on Edgenuity outside of the school day. (HHS does not provide technology.)**
2. Students will be enrolled in one Edgenuity course at a time.
3. Students who are athletes or may be involved in the NCAA, National Collegiate Athletic Association, must indicate such by checking the box on the Edgenuity Student Enrollment Form. This will determine the type of Edgenuity course you will be enrolled in. The NCAA only approves full courses; they will not accept the Credit Recovery version with pretest. If this applies to you, please make sure the course you are enrolled in doesn't have CR after the course title. If it does and you are an athlete, please let your teacher know immediately.
4. Students are expected to follow the pacing expectations below to remain in CRASH. Failure to meet the expectations may result in removal from the program. Removal from the program will result in loss of progress and credit for the course.
 - a. Semester 1
 - i. Students should be 25% done by September 22
 - ii. Students should be 50% done by October 5
 - iii. Students should be 75% done by November 3
 - iv. Students should be 100% done by December 15
 - b. Semester 2
 - i. Students should be 25% done by February 16
 - ii. Students should be 50% done by March 7
 - iii. Students should be 75% done April 8
 - iv. Students should be 100% done by May 17
5. The lab is open during the following times to work on Edgenuity in room 1204 or 1209 for additional support. (Student must work outside of the school day to meet the pacing expectations.)
 - a. During Your Lunch (Feel free to eat in the room while you work. You must get a pass ahead of time)
 - b. Zero Hour 7:45 AM to 8:35 AM (by appointment)
 - c. After School – 4:20 PM to 5:00 PM (by appointment)
6. Students must contact their teacher of record to get tests unlocked, take retakes, and tutoring. The Edgenuity teachers of record can be contacted using the information below by subject area:

7. After two failed attempts, students must meet with their teacher of record for remediation before a third attempt.
8. Your progress will be monitored by your teacher of record and your assigned Interventionist.
