Reporting on Snapchat

Snapchat has not yet developed a system for reporting self-harm or suicide on their app. You must go to the Snapchat Support website and complete the form.

- 1. Note the time, sender, and content of the Snap or Story- you can also take a screenshot but know that the sender will be notified of that
- 2. Go to the **Snapchat Support** website
- 3. Select "Report a safety concern"
- 4. Choose the option most appropriate to your situation
- 5. Click on "It was a threat"
- 6. Select the option for "A suicide threat"
