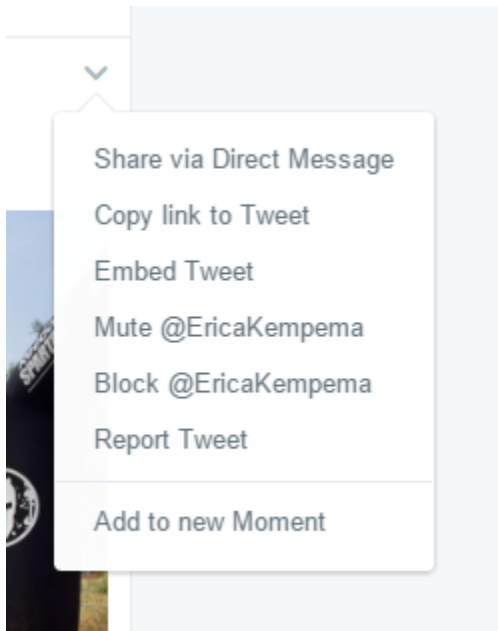
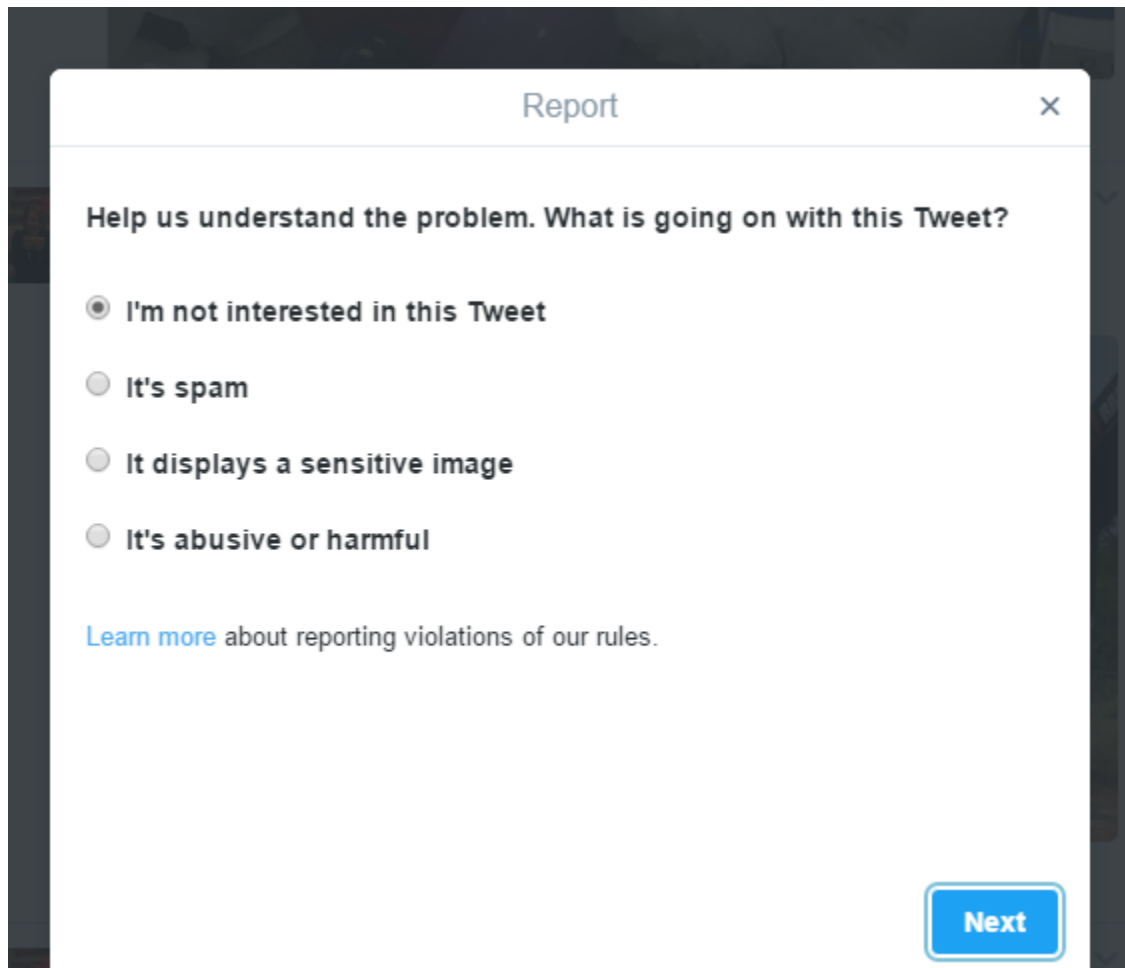


## Reporting on Twitter

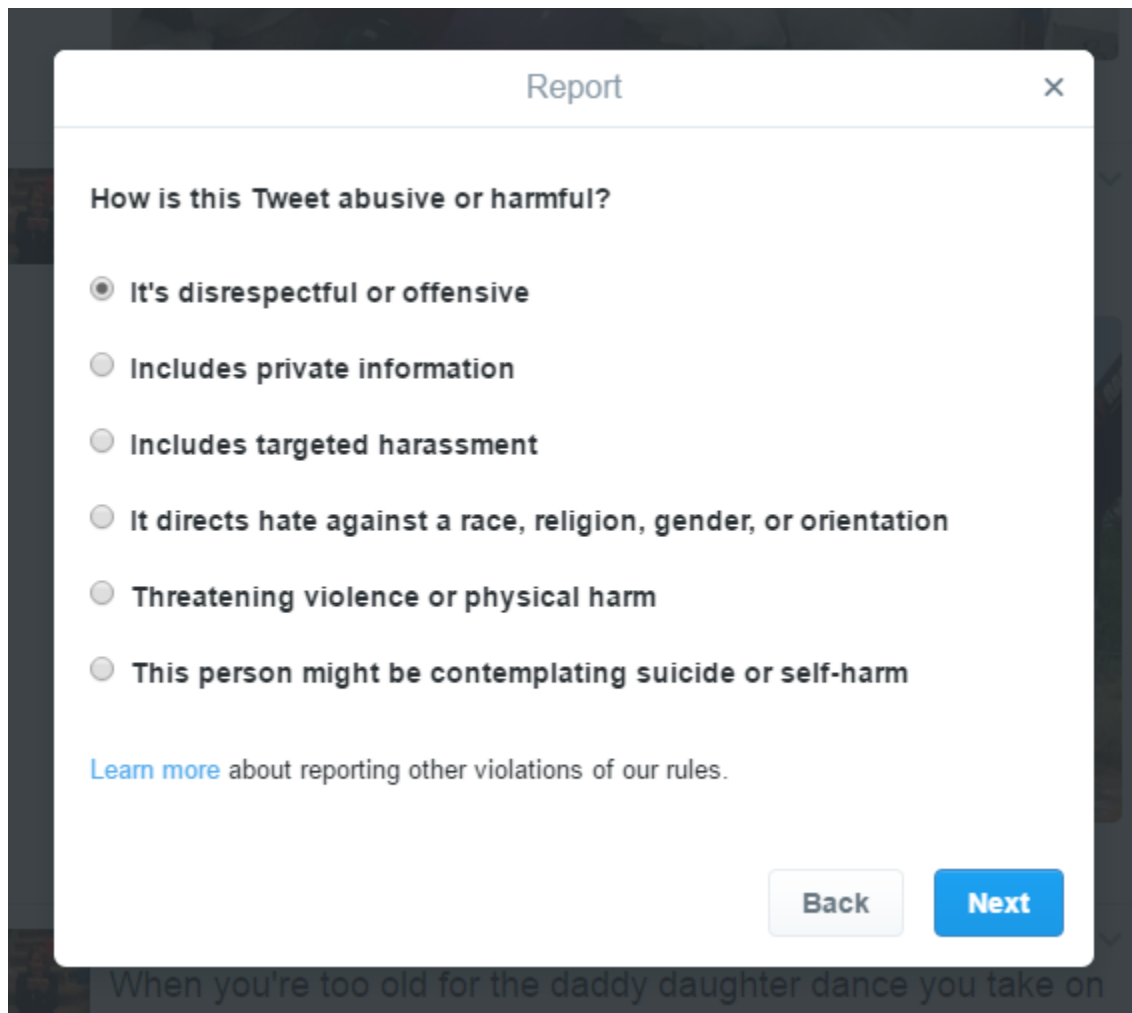
1. Click on the little v in the top right corner and choose "Report Tweet"



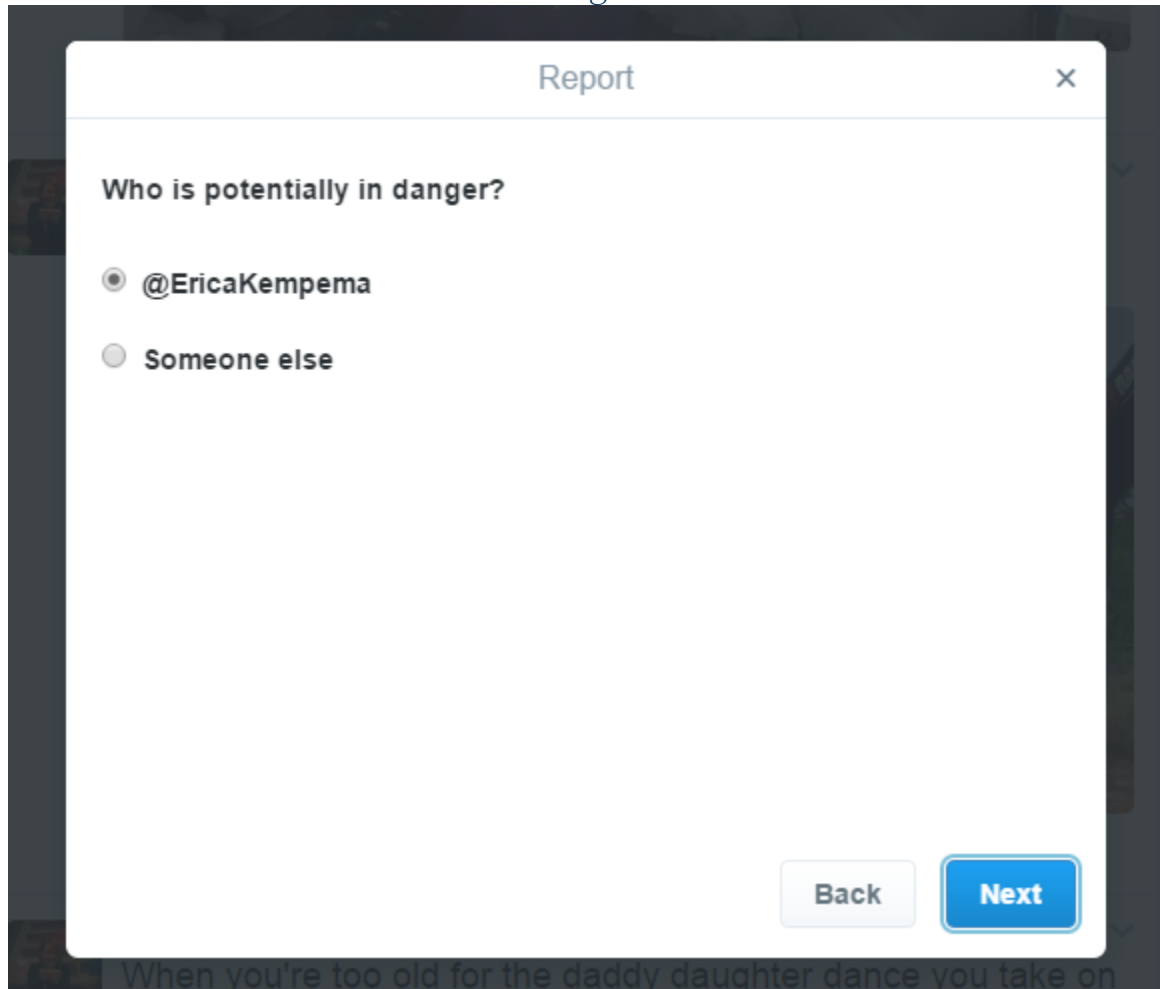
2. Select the option "It's abusive or harmful" on the first Report screen



3. On the next Report screen select "This person might be contemplating suicide or self-harm"

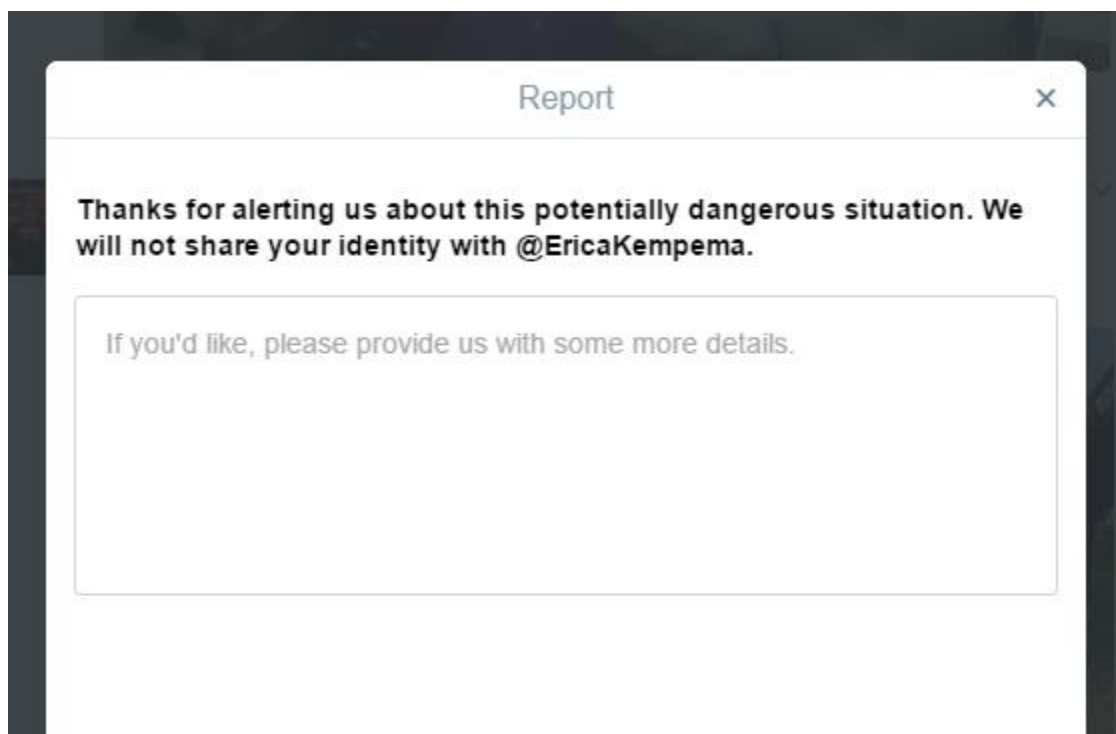


4. If the tweet is referencing themselves choose "@{insert name}" or select "Someone else" if the Tweet is not talking about themselves.
